

During this term, we will be developing our ability to subitise to 3 and show the amount or our fingers. We will be able to recite numbers forwards and backwards and solve problems up to 5.

Maths

In Number pattern, we will identify patterns around me and extend ABAB patterns. We will pick up on errors in a repeating pattern. We will explore 3D shapes and make comparisons within weight.



Understanding the World

During our topics, we will be able to use simple language to table about events in relation to the passing of time. We will talk about significant events in my own life and family. We will talk about our own experiences in Nursery with our families We will create our own simple maps and compare the place we live with a contrasting place. We will Understand the life cycle of a plant and an animal. We will learn to care for the environment.

Computing

We will operate simple games on the iPad and we will know how to open and end a programme.

We will practice typing our name on a keyboard and find given letters without support.

Expressive Arts and Design

During this term, we will select colours for a specific purpose and create closed shapes with continuous lines. We will give meaning to these shapes.

We will become more complex with our drawing Skills and we will use a range of mediums to represen ideas.

We will focus on play being linked to what we see in the community and use objects to represent role play.



Communication and Language

We will learn how to understand two-part questions without prompts. We will ask more open-ended questions 'why'. We will begin to use prepositions in conversation and develop our conversational skills with an adult.

We will ask simple questions to find out more information about stories that we hear.

We will tell longer stories and talk to organize our play. We will express points of view and develop dialogue.
